

Plant/Situation	Pest	Rate	How to Apply
Vegetables, Fruit, Omamental plants	Caterpillars Sooty mould	Mix 10mL per 5L water	Apply when pests appear. Re-apply every 7 days while pests are present. Good coverage is important so apply spray to upper and underside of leaves to point of run-off. Note plant safety CAUTION information. Caterpillars: Use of an emulsified botanical oil spray additive, e.g. eco-oil" is recommended. Note: There may be some species within this pest group that may not be controlled. Sooty mould: Spray insects directly above and around or within the sooty mould affected areas. Mealybugs: use the higher rate when pest numbers are high.
	Aphids, Leaf miner, Leaf Roller, Mites, Potato Beetle, Scale, Thrips, Whitefly	Mix 15-25mL per 5L water	
	Bronze Beetle, Mealybugs, Psyllid	Mix 25mL per 5L water	
Home garden lawns, plant pots and garden beds (ornamentals only)	Grass Grub Beetle	Mix 20mL per 5L water to treat 10 square metres	Apply at the first sign of pest infestation and before pest populations build up to damaging levels. Ensure thorough coverage of treated areas. Apply using a watering can.
	Black Beetle larvae	Mix 10mL per litre water	Apply as a soil drench using a watering can. For Black Beetle, the optimum application time is peak egg hatch which occurs between mid Spring to mid Summer. Ensure thorough coverage of treated areas.
Ornamental citrus	Citrus leaf miner	Mix 25mL per 10L water	Begin applying when new flush growth is 4 cm long. Apply every 5 to 14 days with presence of new flush growth. Ensure that new flush leaves are sprayed on top and underneath.
